

## How to Embed Google Maps in a Webpage

1. Go to <http://maps.google.com>
2. Zoom in on the area to display
3. In the upper right corner of the map click on "Link" (See Screenshot in Figure 1.)
4. In the lower right part of the box that opens click on "Customize and preview embedded map" (See Screenshot in Figure 1.)

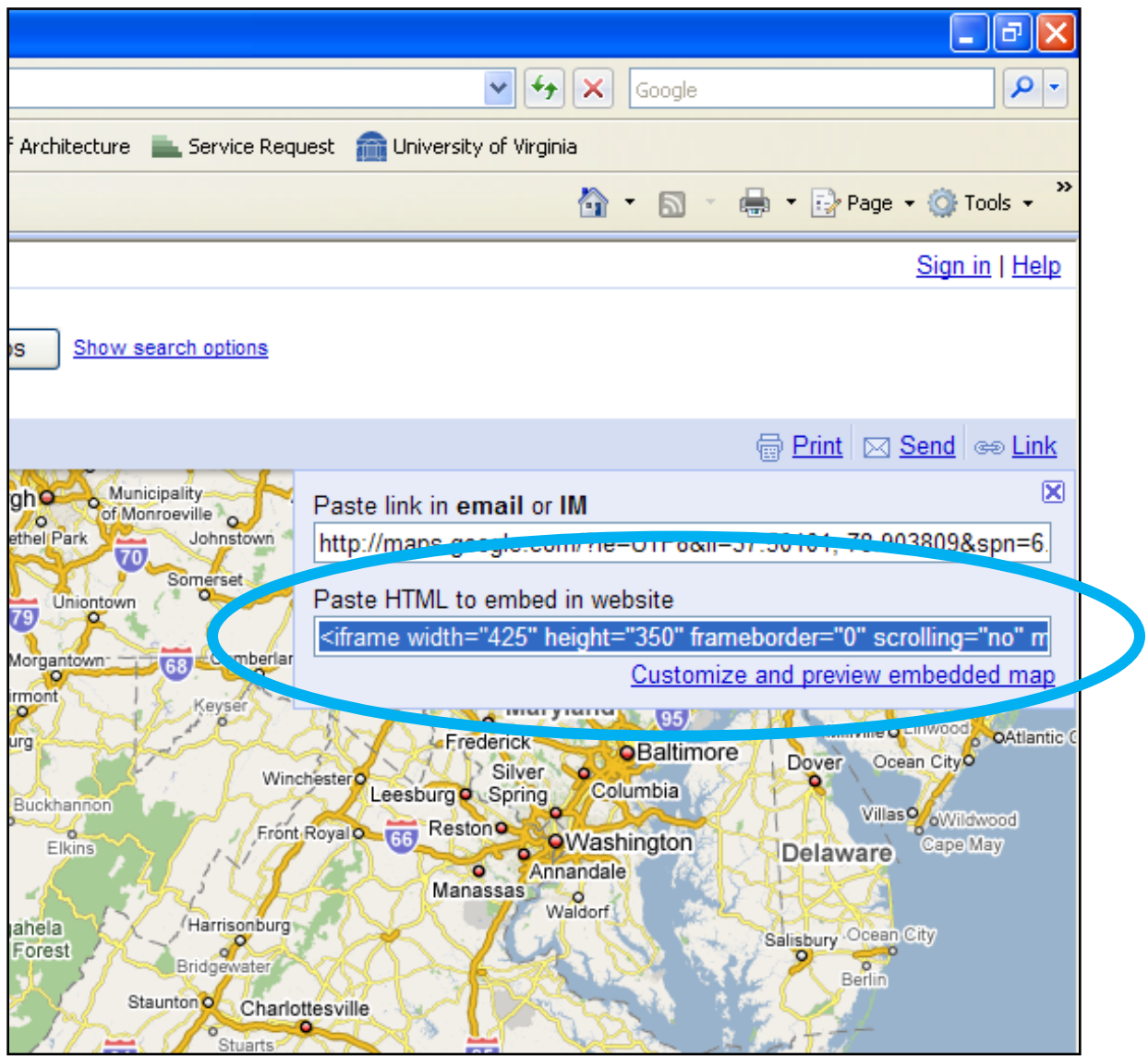
